I, **FAUSTO POCAR**, President of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the Former Yugoslavia since 1991 ("International Tribunal") and Pre-Appeal Judge in this case;¹

CONSIDERING that pursuant to Rule 65bis(B) of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence of the International Tribunal ("Rules"), a status conference should be convened within one hundred and twenty days of the filing of a notice of appeal to allow any person in custody pending appeal the opportunity to raise issues in relation thereto, including the mental and physical condition of that person;

CONSIDERING that the last status conference in the present case was held on 22 August 2008;


CONSIDERING that Dragomir Milošević is currently in detention at the United Nations Detention Unit in The Hague pending appeal;

PURSUANT to Rule 65(B) of the Rules;

HEREBY ORDER that a status conference be held before me on Monday, 24 November 2008, at 8:00 a.m. in Courtroom II.
