**ORDER ON LIFTING CONFIDENTIALITY OF TWO
EXHIBITS AND FOR PROVISION OF DOCUMENTS TO
WITNESS**

TRIAL CHAMBER III (“Trial Chamber”) of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the former Yugoslavia since 1991 (“Tribunal”);

NOTING the oral order by the Trial Chamber during the testimony of witness Andrei Demurenko, in which the Trial Chamber ordered that the witness be provided with all documents pertaining to the Markale II incident during the Prosecution case, so as to enable the witness to prepare himself for cross-examination on this matter;

NOTING that the Trial Chamber has identified exhibits D10, D117, P85, P86, P252, P253, P254, P255, P262, P266, P357, P588 and P631 as such documents;

NOTING that exhibits P252 and P255 were admitted under seal;

CONSIDERING that it is necessary to temporarily lift the confidentiality of these documents for the purposes and the duration of the testimony of said witness;

CONSIDERING that this will not affect the confidential status of the documents for any party other than the witness;

CONSIDERING that the witness is allowed only to review the documents and that he is not to disclose the information contained in the documents to any third party;

CONSIDERING that the lifting of the confidentiality terminates upon completion of the witness’ testimony;

PURSUANT TO Rules 54 and 75 of the Rules;

HEREBY TEMPORARILY LIFTS the confidentiality of exhibits P252 and P255 for the purpose and duration of the testimony of witness Andrei Demurenko and only with regard to said witness,


And **ORDERS**

the Registrar to provide the witness with exhibits D10, D117, P85, P86, P252, P253, P254, P255, P262, P266, P357, P588 and P631 in their original version and the translation thereof, as well as a copy of this order; and

the witness:

1. not to disclose the information contained in exhibits P252 and P255 to any third party;
2. to return the documents and any copies of those documents in his possession to the Registrar upon his return to the Tribunal to continue his testimony.
