**ORDER CONFIRMING ORAL RULING ON
PROTECTIVE MEASURES FOR WITNESS GH-085**



1. **THIS TRIAL CHAMBER** of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the former Yugoslavia since 1991 (“Tribunal”) hereby issues this order confirming the oral ruling of 12 September 2013 on the rescission of the protective measures for witness GH-085.
2. On 24 August 2012, the Trial Chamber granted the Prosecution’s motion for the continuation of the protective measure of a pseudonym for witness GH-085 and for the witness to give evidence in closed session.¹
3. On 12 September 2013, the Prosecution requested the Trial Chamber to rescind the protective measure of closed session for the witness. After hearing the parties, the Trial Chamber heard directly from the witness on the reasons for the request for rescission and decided to grant the request orally from the bench.
4. Accordingly, the Trial Chamber, pursuant to Articles 20, 21, and 22 of the Statute of the Tribunal and Rules 54, 75, and 79 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence of the Tribunal, hereby
 - (a) **CONFIRMS** its oral ruling;
 - (b) **RESCINDS** the protective measure of closed session for witness GH-085; and
 - (c) **INSTRUCTS** the Registry to take all necessary measures to implement this decision.
