I, Iain Bonomy, Judge of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the former Yugoslavia since 1991 (“Tribunal”),

BEING ASSIGNED Pre-Trial Judge in the present case pursuant to Rule 65 *ter* of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence of the Tribunal (“Rules”) by order of the Presiding Judge of Trial Chamber III on 22 August 2008;¹

NOTING that the last Status Conference in this case was held on 28 October 2008;

NOTING that at the last Status Conference it was indicated that the next one would take place on 20 January 2009;

CONSIDERING that all courts are already scheduled to be fully occupied that day;

NOTING Rule 65 *bis* (A) of the Rules, which states that a “Trial Chamber or a Trial Chamber Judge shall convene a status conference within one hundred and twenty days of the initial appearance of the accused and thereafter within one hundred and twenty days after the last status conference”;

PURSUANT TO Rules 54, 65 *bis* and 65 *ter* of the Rules;

HEREBY SCHEDULE a Status Conference for Monday, 19 January 2009 at 2:15 p.m. in Courtroom 1.
