THIS TRIAL CHAMBER of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the Former Yugoslavia since 1991 (“Tribunal”),

CONSIDERING the “Decision on Accused’s Motion to Subpoena John Zametica”, issued on 27 August 2013, in which the Chamber granted the Accused’s “Motion for Subpoena: John Zametica”, filed on 2 July 2013, requesting that a subpoena be issued directing John Zametica to appear before the Chamber to give testimony on 29 October 2013;

PURSUANT TO Article 29 of the Statute of the Tribunal and Rule 54 of the Tribunal’s Rules of Procedure and Evidence;

HEREBY REQUESTS the responsible authorities of the Republic of Austria:

1. To serve the attached Subpoena *ad Testificandum* issued by the Chamber on 27 August 2013 (“Subpoena”) on John Zametica; and
2. To take all reasonable and necessary measures to ensure that John Zametica appears at the time and place indicated in the Subpoena;
3. To provide a written report either confirming, and providing details of, the actual service of the Subpoena or describing the efforts made to serve the Subpoena, and further describing the efforts made to ensure the appearance of John Zametica; and
4. To provide passport information concerning John Zametica within 48 hours of receipt of this Order.
