Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory

of the Former Yugoslavia since 1991 ("the International Tribunal"),

BEING SEISED of an application by the Prosecutor entitled "Application to Vacate Order of

Limited Disclosure" filed on 1st October 2001.

NOTING the order for limited disclosure of indictment IT-01-42-I issued by me on 27 February

2001, which stipulated that there shall be no disclosure of the names of the accused and the text of

the indictment, except to the appropriate authorities of the Republic of Montenegro, until such time

as the accused have been arrested, or until otherwise ordered,

CONSIDERING the request and submissions of the Prosecutor to vacate the order for non-

disclosure of the names of the accused and the text of the indictment,

PURSUANT TO Rules 53(B) and 54 of the Rules,

HEREBY ORDER that the order for limited disclosure of 27 February 2001 be vacated.
