**I, WOLFGANG SCHOMBURG**, a Judge of the Appeals Chamber of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the Former Yugoslavia since 1991 (“International Tribunal”) and Pre-Appeal Judge in this case;

**NOTING** that Rule 65bis(B) of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence (“Rules”) states that “an Appeals Chamber judge shall convene a status conference [...] within one hundred and twenty days after the last status conference, to allow any person in custody pending appeal the opportunity to raise issues in relation thereto, including the mental and physical condition of that person”;

**NOTING** that the last status conference was held on 11 December 2006;


**CONSIDERING** that Momćilo Krajišnik is currently in the United Nations Detention Unit in The Hague pending appeal;
