**ORDER WITHDRAWING CONFIDENTIAL STATUS OF 31 MAY 2006 DECISION

I, **FAUSTO POCAR**, President of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the Former Yugoslavia Since 1991 (“International Tribunal”),

NOTING the “Decision on Request of Zoran Žigić”, issued confidentially on 31 May 2006 (“Decision”);

CONSIDERING that, in the Decision, I dismissed Zoran Žigić’s request to reconsider the “Order Designating the State in which Zoran Žigić is to Serve his Prison Sentence”, issued confidentially on 12 May 2006 (“Order”);


NOTING the “Order Withdrawing Confidential Status of Order Designating the State in which Zoran Žigić is to Serve his Prison Sentence”, issued on 30 January 2008, whereby I ordered that the Order shall be considered a public filing;

CONSIDERING therefore that there is no reason to maintain the confidential status of the Decision;

HEREBY INSTRUCT the Registry of the International Tribunal to lift the confidential status of the Decision, and **ORDER** that the Decision shall henceforth be considered a public filing.
