I, **Mehmet Güney**, Judge of the Appeals Chamber of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the former Yugoslavia since 1991 (“Appeals Chamber” and “Tribunal”, respectively) and Presiding Judge in this case,

NOTING the “Judgement” issued by the Appeals Chamber on 4 December 2012 in this case (“Appeal Judgement”);

NOTING that a clerical error was inadvertently included in the joint dissenting opinion of Judge Pocar and Judge Liu appended to the Appeal Judgement;

ON THE BASIS OF THE FOREGOING,

HEREBY ORDER, at the request of Judge Pocar and Judge Liu and with the consent of the Bench in this case, that the first sentence of paragraph 6 of the joint dissenting opinion of Judge Pocar and Judge Liu appended to the Appeal Judgement shall be amended as follows:

Consequently, we would have affirmed Sredoje Lukić’s convictions for ~~aiding and abetting~~ the beatings of Kustura, and the other detainees.
