I, Patrick Robinson, Presiding Judge of Trial Chamber III of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the former Yugoslavia since 1991 ("Tribunal"),


NOTING that at a Status Conference held on 12 June 2008, it was announced that the Pre-Trial Conference in this case would be held on Wednesday 2 July 2008,

PURSUANT to Rule 54 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence;

HEREBY ORDER as follows:

1. the Pre-Trial Conference in this case will be held on Wednesday, 9 July 2008, commencing at 9 a.m. in Courtroom III;
2. the trial shall commence immediately after the completion of the Pre-Trial Conference with the opening statement of the Prosecution, pursuant to Rule 84 of the Rules;
3. the trial proceedings shall continue with the opening statements of the Defence for the Accused, should the Defence elect to make their opening statement at this stage of the proceedings, rather than after the conclusion of the Prosecution's presentation of evidence and before the presentation of evidence for the defence, as permitted in Rule 84 of the Rules.
