**NOTING** the Chamber’s oral ruling that the Prosecution be allowed to present any arguments that it wishes to raise in relation to the Motion;<sup>2</sup>

**CONSIDERING** that it is in the interest of justice that the Motion be decided expeditiously;

**PURSUANT TO** Rules 54, 126 *bis* and 127 of the Rules,

**ORDERS** the Prosecution to present a response to the Defence Motion, and any arguments made during the hearing held on 29 October relating to the Motion, by Monday 3 November 2008, before 12:00 noon. No Defence replies are envisaged.
