**TRIAL CHAMBER III** (“Trial Chamber”) of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the former Yugoslavia since 1991 (“Tribunal”)

**NOTING** that a number of decisions and orders have been issued recently which impact upon various aspects of scheduling in this case,

**HEREBY ORDERS AND CONFIRMS** as follows:

1. Witness VG-138 shall be heard on Tuesday and Wednesday 11 and 12 November 2008, following which the Prosecution is expected to rest its case;
2. Rule 98 *bis* submissions will be heard immediately thereafter;
3. The Trial Chamber anticipates that it will render its oral decision pursuant to Rule 98 *bis* shortly thereafter;
4. The Defence submissions pursuant to Rule 65 *ter* (G) shall be filed by Wednesday 19 November 2008;
5. The Defence for Sredoje Lukić shall commence the presentation of its case on Monday 24 November 2008; and
6. The Defence for Milan Lukić shall commence the presentation of its case after the close of the case for Sredoje Lukić.
