**THIS TRIAL CHAMBER** of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the former Yugoslavia since 1991 (“Tribunal”) was seised of a confidential “Prosecution Motion for Trial-Related Protective Measures for Witness K79,” filed 26 January 2007 (“Motion”), requesting trial-related protective measures of image and voice distortion for witness K79,<sup>1</sup> and hereby confirms its oral ruling thereon.


1. The Defence opposed the Motion;<sup>2</sup> and, on 31 January 2007, the Chamber heard oral argumentation regarding this matter.<sup>3</sup> After having heard the parties and deliberating upon the matter, the Chamber granted the Motion during the hearing held on 1 February 2007.

2. The Trial Chamber, pursuant to Rules 53, 54, and 75 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence of the Tribunal, hereby CONFIRMS its oral ruling and ORDERS as follows:

- (a) Witness K79 shall give his/her testimony with the use of image distortion.
- (b) Witness K79 shall give his/her testimony with the use of voice distortion.
- (c) All previously ordered protective measures in relation to this witness shall remain in force.

3. The Chamber hereby INSTRUCTS the Registry to take all necessary measures to implement this Decision.
