THIS TRIAL CHAMBER of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the former Yugoslavia since 1991 (“Tribunal”) is seised of the “Defence Notice Regarding Exhibit 2D389,” filed by Šainović Defence on 7 September 2007, and the “Defence Request Regarding Exhibit 2D389,” filed by the Šainović Defence on 27 September 2007 (“Motion”), requesting the admission of exhibit 2D389 together with its translation, and hereby issues this order thereon.

1. On 6 September 2007, exhibit 2D389, namely “Collegium of the Chief of General Staff of the Yugoslav Army of 30 October 1998,” was marked for identification in eCourt, pending translation.¹ In the Motion, the Šainović Defence informs the Trial Chamber that exhibit 2D389 has been translated into English and uploaded to eCourt. Further, the Defence requests that the exhibit and its translation be admitted into evidence.
2. The Prosecution does not oppose the Motion.
3. Accordingly, the Trial Chamber, pursuant to Rules 54 and 89 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence of the Tribunal, hereby GRANTS the Motion and ORDERS that exhibit 2D389 and its translation shall be admitted into evidence.
