**I, FAUSTO POCAR**, President of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the former Yugoslavia since 1991 (“International Tribunal”),

**NOTING** the letter from the Secretary General of the United Nations (“Secretary-General”) dated 13 July 2007, in which Judge Flavia Lattanzi is appointed to serve as an *ad litem* judge in the International Tribunal for the trial of *Prosecutor v. Rasim Delić*, Case No. IT-04-83, effective 2 July 2007;<sup>1</sup>

**NOTING** the letter from the Secretary General dated 15 October 2007, in which Judge Flavia Lattanzi is appointed to serve as an *ad litem* judge in the International Tribunal for the trial of *Prosecutor v. Vojislav Šešelj*, Case No. IT-03-67, effective 15 October 2007;<sup>2</sup>

**NOTING** the letter from the Secretary General dated 25 February 2008, in which Judge Michèle Picard is appointed to serve as an *ad litem* judge in the International Tribunal for the trial of *Prosecutor v. Jovica Stanišić and Franko Simatović*, Case No. IT-03-69, effective 27 February 2008;<sup>3</sup>

**NOTING** Security Council Resolution 1481(2003), which grants *ad litem* judges the authority to adjudicate in pre-trial proceedings in cases other than those that they have been appointed to try, as reflected in Article 13 *quater* (1)(d) of the International Tribunal’s Statute;

**CONSIDERING** Article 14(5) of the Statute and Rule 19(A) of the International Tribunal’s Rules of Procedure and Evidence, and the trial management and case distribution needs of the International Tribunal;


