NOTING the “Order Assigning Judges to a Case Before a Trial Chamber”, issued 30 June 2006, ordering that Judge O-Gon Kwon shall be assigned to the Bench in *Prosecutor v. Popović et al.*, Case No. IT-05-88;

NOTING that Rule 19 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence of the International Tribunal authorizes the President of the International Tribunal to coordinate the work of the Chambers;


