THIS TRIAL CHAMBER of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the former Yugoslavia since 1991 (“Tribunal”):

NOTING the “Decision on Nikolić Motion for Issuance of a Subpoena”, in which the Trial Chamber granted Nikolić’s motion requesting a subpoena compelling Witness 3DW18 to appear before the Trial Chamber, and the “Subpoena ad testificandum”, both issued on 23 September 2008;

NOTING that Counsel for Drago Nikolić on 2 October 2008 withdrew Witness 3DW18;¹


PURSUANT TO Rule 54 of the Rules,
