TRIAL CHAMBER III (“Chamber”) of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the Former Yugoslavia since 1991,

NOTING the “Order on the Provisional Release of the Accused *Proprio Motu*”, issued by the Chamber on 6 November 2014 as a public document with a confidential annex (“Order of 6 November 2014”, “Annex”), wherein the Chamber authorises the provisional release of Vojislav Šešelj (“Accused”) to the Republic of Serbia pending delivery of the judgement,

CONSIDERING that the Annex sets out the conditions and practical arrangements of the provisional release of the Accused; that he was released provisionally and is now in the Republic of Serbia,

CONSIDERING that the Chamber deems that, at this stage, there is no reason to justify keeping the Annex confidential and that, consequently, it is in the interest of justice to make it public,

FOR THE FOREGOING REASONS

PURSUANT TO Rule 54 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence,

ORDERS the Registrar of the Tribunal to lift the confidentiality of the Annex,
