
**THIS TRIAL CHAMBER** of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the Former Yugoslavia since 1991 ("International Tribunal"),

**BEING SEISED** of a request from the Federal Republic of Yugoslavia dated 2 July ("Request"), in which it seeks a two week extension of time to conduct investigations in accordance with the Trial Chamber's "Order for the Immediate Cessation of Violations of Protective Measures for Witnesses" of 18 June 2002,

**NOTES** the arguments set out in the Request, and

**HEREBY GRANTS** the Request, and **ORDERS** that the Federal Republic of Yugoslavia provide the Trial Chamber with a report on the investigations and measures taken by 1 August 2002.
