I, **THEODOR MERON**, President of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the Former Yugoslavia Since 1991,

NOTING that, by my order issued on 30 May 2003, this case has been assigned to a Trial Chamber composed of Judges Richard May, Patrick Robinson and O-Gon Kwon;

CONSIDERING the need to expedite the proceedings in this case;

NOTING the appointment of Judge Albertus Henricus Joannes Swart by the Secretary-General of the United Nations as an *ad litem* judge of the Tribunal;


HEREBY ASSIGN, with immediate effect, Judge Albertus Henricus Joannes Swart to replace Judge Richard May in the present case;
