TRIAL CHAMBER III (“Trial Chamber”) of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the Former Yugoslavia since 1991 (“Tribunal”);

NOTING the report submitted to the Trial Chamber on 1 April 2008 by Dr. De Man, a neuro-psychiatrist appointed by the Registrar on 27 March 2008, concerning the mental health of the Accused Jovica Stanišić;

NOTING in particular that Dr. De Man in his report concludes that Jovica Stanišić is “clearly unfit to stand trial on psychiatric grounds only” and that he does not expect his fitness “to be restored within three, possibly six months”;

CONSIDERING the arguments made by the parties during the hearing of 2 April 2008;

CONSIDERING that during the hearing of 2 April 2008, the Parties agreed that it could be helpful to call Dr. De Man to clarify his report;

CONSIDERING that it is in the interest of justice to call Dr. de Man as a witness in order to allow the Parties and the Trial Chamber to question him in relation to his report;

CONSIDERING the report of the UNDU medical officer of 28 March 2008, indicating that as of 27 March 2008 the Accused Jovica Stanišić was hospitalised and was expected to undergo a specific treatment at the UNDU Penitentiary Hospital for a period of seven days;

PURSUANT to Rule 54 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence,

- (1) **SETS** Monday 7 April 2008 at 14.15 hours as the date and time at which Dr. De Man shall be heard;
- (2) **INVITES** the Registrar to make all the necessary arrangements for Dr. De Man to attend that hearing; and
- (3) **CANCELS** the hearings scheduled to take place on 3 and 4 April 2008.
