**ORDER SUSPENDING TIME LIMIT FOR FILING RESPONSE

I, KIMBERLY PROST, Pre-Trial Judge of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the Former Yugoslavia since 1991 (“Tribunal”);

NOTING that the initial appearance took place on Monday 4 June 2007, at which Zdravko Tolimir expressed his wish to represent himself during the initial stage of the proceedings until a permanent counsel is appointed to him;¹


NOTING the “Prosecution’s Motion for Joinder of Accused”, filed by the Prosecution on 6 June 2007 (“Joinder Motion”), in which the Prosecution requests an order joining this case with the case of *Prosecutor v. Popović et al.*;

NOTING that in the Joinder Motion, the Prosecution further requests that all deadlines and timetables associated with the motion be suspended until Counsel is assigned to Zdravko Tolimir;²

PURSUANT TO Rule 126 *bis* of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence,

HEREBY ORDERS that the time limit applicable for filing a response to the Joinder Motion be suspended forthwith until a further order is issued.
