
NOTING the “Registry Submission pursuant to Rule 33(B) concerning the Accused’s Medical Monitoring”, filed confidentially and *ex parte* on 8 June 2009 (“Registry Submission”), which contains personal information regarding the Accused’s health and monitoring measures in place related thereto;

CONSIDERING that at the Status Conference held on 25 June 2009, the Accused expressly indicated his preference that the issues of his health and conditions of detentions should be discussed publicly and therefore I determined to discuss the information contained in the Registry Submission in public session;¹

PURSUANT TO Rule 54 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence;

HEREBY ORDER that the confidential and *ex parte* status of the Registry Submission be lifted.
