#### DECISION ON DESIGNATION OF STANDBY COUNSEL

On 15 April 2010, the Chamber designated Richard Harvey as standby counsel in these proceedings and requested the Registry and the Prosecution to continue to take all necessary measures to ensure that Harvey is able to fulfil his role.

The Chamber specified that his functions would be as follows:

- to receive copies of all court documents, filings and disclosed materials generated by or sent to the accused;
- to be present in the courtroom during the proceedings, assisted by one member of his team, should he consider it to be necessary;
- to engage actively in ongoing substantive preparation of the case, in order to be prepared to put questions to witnesses on behalf of the accused, or to represent his interests, at any time, should the Trial Chamber find this to be necessary;
- to address the Chamber whenever so requested by the Chamber
