# DECISION OF THE PRESIDENT ON JADRANKO PRLIĆ'S MOTION TO DISQUALIFY JUDGE ÁRPAD PRANDLER

On 4 October 2010, Judge Robinson denied the Defence's motion to disqualify Judge Prandler.

## DÉCISION PORTANT REPRISE DU PROCÈS

On 6 October 2010, the Trial Chamber ordered that the proceedings be resumed, following the President's decision to dismiss the motion for disqualification.

## DÉCISION PORTANT SUR LA REQUÊTE DE L'ACCUSATION EN RÉOUVERTURE DE SA CAUSE

On 6 October 2010, the Trial Chamber partially granted the Prosecution's request to reopen its case in order to tender Mladić's notebooks into evidence. Judge Antonetti appended a dissenting opinion.
