# DECISION ON ACCUSED'S FORTY-SEVENTH MOTION FOR FINDING OF DISCLOSURE VIOLATION AND FOR FURTHER SUSPENSION OF PROCEEDINGS

On 10 May 2011, the Chamber granted in part (Judge Kwon dissented) the accused's motion, found that the Prosecution had violated Rule 68 of the Rules with respect to the disclosure of certain documents and ordered that the proceedings be suspended for a further week and would therefore resume on 30 May 2011. However, on 11 May, the Chamber issued a corrigendum to this decision and ordered that the trial would resume on 31 May 2011 (due to unavoidable scheduling reasons).

# Vojislav ŠEŠELJ case ("Contempt")

#### **SCHEDULING ORDER**

On 10 May 2011, the Chamber ordered that the trial should recommence on 6 June 2011 at 14:30. The accused is granted five hours to present his case.
