# DECISION ON ACCUSED'S MOTION TO RECALL TWELVE MUNICIPALITIES WITNESSES

On 20 December 2011, the Chamber denied the accused's motion to recall twelve witnesses who testified in respect to the 'Municipalities' component of the case. The Chamber concluded, *inter alia*, that it was not convinced that any of the documents, Karadžić sought to use with the witnesses would be significant to assessing an important part of their evidence.
