# ICTY WEEKLY UPDATE – 681

## PROCEDURAL DEVELOPMENTS

### I. OVERVIEW OF COURT PROCEEDINGS

#### **MLADIĆ case**

*Trial Chamber I – Judges Orić (Presiding), Flügel and Moloto*

#### **Continuation of the Prosecution case**

## II. OVERVIEW OF SELECTED COURT DOCUMENTS

### **PRLIĆ *et al.* case**

*ICTY Registrar John Hocking*

#### **DECISION**

On 22 August 2012, the Registrar, having found that the Accused was entirely able to remunerate counsel in full, decided that Slobodan Praljak would bear the entirety of the costs of his Defence, including all funds previously expended by the Tribunal, namely 3,293,347.49 euros. However, the decision is stayed until the expiration of the Accused's time to appeal.

### **ŠEŠELJ ("second contempt") case**

*Appeals Chamber – Judges Ramaroson (Presiding), Güney, Pocar, Daqun and Vaz*

#### **DECISION ON AMICUS CURIAE PROSECUTOR'S MOTION FOR A DECLARATION THAT VOJISLAV ŠEŠELJ HAS WAIVED HIS RIGHT TO APPEAL**

On 23 August 2012, the Chamber found that the Accused had waived his right to appeal (because he had not refiled a notice of appeal and the appeal brief) and declared the briefing in this case completed.

### **KARADŽIĆ case**

*Trial Chamber III – Judges Kwon (Presiding), Morrison, Baird and Lattanzi*

#### **DECISION ON THE ACCUSED'S SECOND MOTION FOR SUBPOENA TO INTERVIEW PRESIDENT BILL CLINTON**

On 21 August 2012, the Chamber denied Karadzic's motion for a subpoena against Bill Clinton in order to interview him about the arms shipments to Bosnia and the U.S. military support to the Muslims and Croats in 1995.
