WITHDRAWAL OF MOTION TO REPORT GERMANY TO UNITED NATIONS SECURITY COUNCIL

On 3 September 2012 (made public on 6 September), the Defence withdrew its motion to report Germany to the UN Security Council because Christoph von Bezold, a German citizen and a former member of the ECMM in Zagreb, voluntarily submitted to an interview by Karadzic's legal advisor in Munich on 31 August 2012.
