DECISION

On 10 October 2012, the Registrar determined that Karadzic was able to renumerate his Defence team in part, and decided that Karadzic should contribute 146,501 euros to the cost of his Defence before the ICTY. The rest of the expenses would be borne by the Tribunal. The accused was informed that this contribution would be deducted from future allotments to the Defence in a manner to be agreed upon by him and the Registrar.
