ORDER FOR SAFE CONDUCT

On 25 January 2013, the Chamber ordered the safe conduct of witness Aleksandar Vasiljević, former Head of the Security Department of the Yugoslav People's Army. The order was granted because of the pending indictment against him issued by Croatian authorities. The safe conduct basically means that he "shall not be arrested, detained, prosecuted, or subjected to any other restriction, whether physical or legal, of his personal liberty, in respect of alleged acts or convictions prior to his departure from Serbia." It will be applied throughout the whole trip from Serbia to the Netherlands. His testimony is expected to take place in February 2013.

ORDER FOR SAFE CONDUCT

On 25 January 2013, the Chamber ordered the safe conduct of witness Edin Garaplija, former operative of the Ministry of Interior of Bosnia and Herzegovina. The order was granted because Garaplija had been banned from travel to countries in the Schengen area. His testimony is expected to take place on 6 February 2013.
