DECISION ON TOLIMIR REQUEST FOR CERTIFICATION TO APPEAL SUBPOENA DECISION

On 4 June 2013, the Chamber in Karadžić case grants the application by Zdravko Tolimir to appeal the decision issuing him a subpoena in order to testify in this case. Therefore, the execution of the previous subpoena decision is currently stayed pending the resolution by the Appeals Chamber. Judge Morrison appended a dissenting opinion.
