#### ORDER ASSIGNING A SPECIALLY APPOINTED CHAMBER

On 1 October 2013, President Meron composed a specially-appointed Chamber to consider whether to appoint an *amicus curiae* Prosecutor to investigate possible contempt of court by Carla Del Ponte, as requested by Karadžić. The Chamber consists of judges Flügge, Moloto and Hall.
