#### DECISION ON ACCUSED'S MOTION TO VARY LIST OF WITNESSES: SREBRENICA & MUNICIPALITIES COMPONENTS

On 4 November 2013, the Chamber granted the Karadžić's motion for an addition of two witnesses related to the Srebrenica events as well as the withdrawal of 98 municipalities-related ones from his witness list.
