DECISION ON THE APPLICATION OF RULE 73 ter (E) AND ON DEFENCE MOTION TO MODIFY THE TRIAL SCHEDULE DURING THE TESTIMONY OF MR. HADŽIĆ

On 24 June 2014, the Chamber decided that Hadžić Defence would have a total time of 140 hours to lead its evidence. It also granted the Defence's motion to sit four days per week for the duration of the testimony of the accused, who is the first Defence witness.

ORDER INVITING HOST COUNTRY AND RECEIVING STATE TO PRESENT THEIR COMMENTS WITH REGARD TO GUARANTEES FOR A POSSIBLE PROVISIONAL RELEASE OF THE ACCUSED *PROPRIO MOTU*

On 24 June 2014, the Chamber requested the government of Serbia to confirm, within 7 days from the date of receipt of this decision, if it is able to guarantee a number of proposed measures for the potential provisional release of Šešelj. The Government of Netherlands has also been called upon to provide its observations about the matter.
