ORDER ON RECLASSIFICATION OF AUDIO AND VIDEO RECORDINGS

On 15 July 2014, the Appeals Chamber ordered the reclassification of the recordings (audio and video) of the testimonies of protected witnesses BX and CD from 25 October and 22 November 2006. The order reads that "any person or organisation, including media organisations, in possession of the recordings, whether in whole or in part, is hereby enjoined from disclosing them to any other person or organisation as of the filing date of this order and is warned that any such disclosure may result in proceedings for contempt against the disclosing person(s) or organisation(s)."
