INTERLOCUTORY APPEAL OF THE 27 MARCH 2015 DECISION ON DEFENCE REQUEST TO ADOPT MODALITY FOR PROSECUTION RE-OPENING

On 24 April 2015, Mladić Defence filed its interlocutory appeal against the Chamber's decision granting one month for the Defence to prepare for the reopening of the Prosecution case. The Defence seeks more time to prepare for the reopening and requests the Appeals Chamber to vacate and reverse the impugned decision.
