CONSOLIDATED DECISION ON THE CONTINUATION OF PROCEEDINGS

On 26 October 2015, the Trial Chamber granted, in part, the Defence's motion and ordered a stay of the proceedings for the initial period of three months. It was concluded that a suspension of the proceedings is the most prudent course of action because "it allows the Chamber to remain seized of the proceedings and to continue to monitor Hadžić's health, and also leaves open the possibility, however improbable, that, in the event that Hadžić's health does improve, the Chamber will be able to resume proceedings."
