PROCEDURAL DEVELOPMENTS

I. OVERVIEW OF COURT PROCEEDINGS

POPOVIĆ et al. Case

Trial Chamber II - Judges Agius (Presiding), Kwon, Prost and Støle (Reserve Judge)

Continuation of the Defence case

On 28 July 2008, the following witnesses testified:

- **Špiro Pereula** (officer in the Republika Srpska Army/Main Staff and the Ministry of Defence during the relevant period)
- *Miladin Jovanović* (member of the Republika Srpska Army during the relevant period)

On 28 July and 29 July 2008, the following witness testified:

• *Perica Vasović* (testifying about the events in Kravica, near Srebrenica, during the relevant period)

On 29 July 2008, the following witness testified:

• *Ljuban Mrković* (security organ in the Aircraft Manufacturing Plant "Orao" during the relevant period)

From 29 July until 31 July 2008, the following witness testified:

• **Svetlana Radovanović** (expert witness-demographer)

The trial will resume on 25 August 2008.

Judge Prost

On 30 July 2008, the parties met before Judge Prost for a Status Conference. The accused was present.

KARADŽIĆ Case

Judge Orie

Initial appearance

On 31 July 2008, the parties met before Judge Orie for the initial appearance of Radovan Karadžić. He chose to postpone his plea entering, after which Judge Orie scheduled the further appearance of the accused for 29 August 2008.

Ljubiša PETKOVIĆ Case ("Contempt")

Appeals Chamber – Judges Pocar (Presiding), Shahabuddeen, Güney, Vaz and Meron

DECISION ON DEFENCE APPEAL AGAINST THE TRIAL CHAMBER'S DECISION ON PROVISIONAL RELEASE

On 25 July 2008, the Appeals Chamber dismissed an appeal by the Defence against the decision denying provisional release for the accused.

STANIŠIĆ& SIMATOVIĆ Case

Trial Chamber III – Judges Robinson (Presiding), David and Picard

ORDER VARYING MEDICAL REPORTING REGIME DURING PROVISIONAL RELEASE

On 29 July 2008, the Trial Chamber ordered the Government of Serbia to ensure strict compliance with the revised reporting regime as to the medical condition of the accused Stanišić. The details of the regime are specified in the order.

Trial Chamber III – Judges Bonomy (Presiding), Chowhan, Kamenova and Nosworthy (Reserve Judge)

ORDER ON ALLOCATION OF TIME FOR CLOSING ARGUMENTS

On 30 July 2008, the Trial Chamber ordered that the Prosecution shall have nine hours in which to present its closing arguments whereas each of the accused shall have two and a half hours. The Chamber shall decide upon time for rebuttal and rejoinder arguments (if any), after the completion of the Defence arguments.

GOTOVINA et al. Case

Trial Chamber I – Judges Orie (Presiding), Ķinis and Gwaunza

ORDER TO LIFT THE CONFIDENTIAL STATUS OF THE DECISION ON IVAN ČERMAK'S MOTION FOR PROVISIONAL RELEASE

On 1 August 2008, the Trial Chamber requested the Registry to lift the confidential status of the decision, filed on 18 July 2008, granting provisional release for Ivan Čermak from 25 July until 21 August 2008. However, the decision was stayed pending an appeal.
