Judge Robinson

Further appearance/Status Conference

On 20 November 2008, the parties appeared before Judge Robinson for the further appearance/Status Conference with the accused Župljanin present in the courtroom whereas Mićo Stanišić participated via video-link from Belgrade. Both accused pleaded not guilty to all new charges from the consolidated (joinder) indictment.

LUKIĆ&LUKIĆ Case

Deputy Registrar Trial Chamber III – Judges Robinson (Presiding), Van den Wyngaert and David

DECISION

On 18 November 2008, the Deputy Registrar decided, pursuant to Rule 64 of the Rules, to prohibit all communications of Milan Lukić, except those with counsel and consular representatives, for a period of two weeks, effective as of the date of this decision. This decision followed a letter by the Prosecution alleging that the accused may have called from the UN Detention Unit and intimidated the family of a Prosecution witness.

DECISION ON MILAN LUKIĆ'S MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO PREPARE THE DEFENCE CASE-IN-CHIEF

On 18 November 2008, Trial Chamber III granted in part a motion by the Defence of Milan Lukić, allowing an additional week before the commencement of the Defence cases. The Chamber ordered that the Defence for Sredoje Lukić shall commence its case on 1 December 2008, and the Defence for Milan Lukić shall be ready to present its case immediately after that.
