CELEBICI CASE:

As previously scheduled, the Defence of the four accused has started to present its case. It is expected that around 100 witnesses will be called by the four defendants' counsels.

Various changes have occured in the Defense team of Esad LANDZO: John Ackerman has been replaced as lead-counsel by Ms Cynthia McMurrey, who previouly was co-counsel. She has temporarily been replaced as co-counsel by Ms Nancy BOLER from the United States, Texas Bar.

Due to the celebration of Bajram (muslim holidays) the Celebeci trial will <u>not</u> sit on Tuesday 7 and Wednesday 8 April 1998.
