KUPRESKIC CASE: DEFENDANT VLATKO KUPRESKIC SEEKS LEAVE TO APPEAL:

On 15 September 1998, Defendant Vlatko KUPRESKIC filed an application for leave to appeal against the oral ruling of Trial Chamber II on 17 August denying his request for the assignment of Mr. Zelimir Par as co-counsel.

The Defendant contends that this ruling prejudices his defence since "attorney Par has, since the moment of Vlatko Kupreskic's apprehension, been participating actively in the preparation of his defence, as a person of full trust to the accused". Another argument is that the current lead counsel, Mr. Borislav Krajina, has "prepared the defence of the accused in such a manner that one part of the defence be independently prepared and presented by attorney Zelimir Par".

SLOBODAN MILJKOVIC CASE: DEATH OF THE ACCUSED CONFIRMED:

On 14 September 1998, the Office of the Prosecutor filed with the Registry the death certificate of Slobodan Miljkovic. The latter died on 8 August 1998 in Kragujevac (Serbia) of multiple gunshots in the chest and abdomen. Slobodan Milikovic was indicted on 21 July 1995 for his alleged involvement in the campaign of terror undertaken in April 1992 by Serb military forces from Bosnia and elsewhere in the former Yugoslavia against the Bosnian Croat and Muslim residents of the Bosanski Samac area. According to the indictment, Slobodan Miljkovic, also known as Lugar, was at that time the Deputy Commander of "The Grey Wolves", a paramilitary unit from Serbia.

Slobodan Miljkovic was indicted along with five co-defendants. Three of them, namely Milan Simic, Miroslav Tadic and Simo Zaric are in the custody of the ICTY: the charges against them were recently re-formulated in an amended indictment, which is available on the ICTY Internet Homepage.
