DELALIC & OTHERS ("Celebici") CASE:

LANDZO'S SECOND MOTION TO PRESERVE AND PROVIDE EVIDENCE GRANTED IN **PART**

On 15 June 1999, the Appeals Chamber (Judges Hunt (Presiding), Riad, Wang, Nieto-Navia and Bennouna) granted in part Esad Landzo's Second Motion to Preserve and Provide Evidence, filed on 12 May 1999. The Second Motion was filed pursuant to the Appeals Chamber's Decision on the Motion to Preserve and Provide Evidence, dated 22 April 1999 (see Update No. 74).

The Appeals Chamber dismissed the application for preservation of the videotapes as unnecessary, but ordered that Counsel for the Appellant may view the videotapes of the proceedings. The Chamber ordered that viewing, which is subject to protective measures, is to take place between Wednesday 16 June 1999 and Monday 13 September 1999 at the Tribunal, and that the Prosecution is permitted to view the video tapes to which the Appellant has been granted access.

DECISION ON APELLANTS' SECOND MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE **BRIEF**

On 15 June 1999, the Appeals Chamber rejected the Appellant-Cross Appellee's Second Motion for Extension of Time to File Brief, filed on 26 May 1999 (see Update No. 79). The Chamber considered that the Appellants are able to supplement their appellant briefs at a later date by filing an application for leave to do so.

However, in a subsequent Order of the same date, the Appeals Chamber granted in part Esad Landzo's Second Motion for an Extension of time to File Brief. Further to its Order on the Second Motion to Preserve and Provide Evidence, dated 15 June 1999 (see above), the Appeals Chamber granted Esad Landzo leave to file a supplementary appellant brief in relation to the video recording by Monday 13 September 1999.

DECISION ON THE MOTION TO SEVER APPEALS RESERVED

On 15 June 1999, the Appeals Chamber issued its Order on the Request of Zejnil Delalic to Determine his Previously Filed Motion for Severance. The Chamber continued to reserve its decision on the Motion to Severe Appeals until it has received the appellant briefs defining the grounds of appeal or cross-appeal which are due to be filed on 2 July 1999.

SIMIC & OTHERS ("Bosanski Samac") CASE:

ASSIGMENT OF JUDGES FOR INTERLOCUTORY APPEAL; SCHEDULING ORDER

Further to the Decision by a Bench of the Appeals Chamber on 8 June 1999, granting Miroslav Tadic's Application for Leave to Appeal the Decision Regarding Provisional Release (see Update No. 81), and an Order, dated 11 June 1999, issued by Judge Gabrielle Kirk McDonald, President of the Tribunal, assigning Judges Kirk McDonald (Presiding), Shahabuddeen, Wang, Nieto-Navia and Mumba as members of the Appeals Chamber for the purpose of deciding the merits of that Appeal.

On 14 June 1999, the Appeals Chamber ordered: (1) the Appellant to file an appeal brief by 21 June 1999, (2) the Prosecution to file its Response by 25 June 1999, and (3) the Appellant to reply to the Prosecutor's Response by 29 June 1999.

ASSIGMENT OF JUDGES FOR THE APPEAL

On 11 June 1999, Judge Gabrielle Kirk McDonald, President of the Tribunal, assigned Judges Shahabuddeen, Wang, May, Mumba and Hunt as members of the Appeals Chamber for the purpose of the Appeal by the Prosecution and Defence against the Judgement of Trial Chamber I *bis* rendered on 7 May 1999 (see Update No. 78).

ASSIGNMENT OF THE CASE TO A TRIAL CHAMBER

Further to the transfer of Dragan Kolundzija to the custody of the Tribunal on 7 June 1999 (see Press Release No. 407, 10 June 1999). On 10 June 1999, Judge Gabrielle Kirk McDonald, the President of the Tribunal, assigned the case to Trial Chamber III comprised of Judges May (Presiding), Bennouna and Robinson.

ASSIGNMENT OF DEFENCE COUNSEL

Further to a request by the accused Dragan Kolundzija, on 16 June 1999, the Registrar temporarily assigned Mr. Dusan Vucicevic as Defence Counsel as of 16 June 1999, for a period not exceeding 30 days.

Mr. Eugene O'Sullivan had been temporarily assigned to represent the accused at the initial appearance hearing on 14 June 1999 due to the unavailability of Mr. Vucicevic (see Press Release No. 410, 15 June 1999).
