#### PROCEDURAL DEVELOPMENTS:

#### I. OVERVIEW OF COURT PROCEEDINGS:

# Stanislav GALIĆ Case ("Sarajevo")

Trial Chamber I Section B – Judges Orie (Presiding), El Mahdi and Nieto-Navia

On 4 February 2002, the seventh week of the Prosecution case started with the testimony of witness Fatima Salčin. The Prosecution then called witness Mirsad Abdurahmanović who testified about sniping incidents in Sarajevo.

On 5 February, the Prosecution called witness Akif Mukanović who also testified about sniping that took place in Sarajevo. Following the cross-examination, the Prosecution called witness Nafa Tarić.

On 6 February, the Defence cross-examined Nafa Tarić. The next witness examined by the Prosecution was Mensur Jusić who also testified about sniping incidents in Sarajevo.

On the following day, Mensur Jusić was cross-examined by the Defence. After re-examination by the Prosecution and a short examination by the Judges, the Prosecution called protected witness M.

# Radoslav BRĐANIN and Momir TALIĆ Case

Trial Chamber II Section A - Judges Agius (Presiding), Janů and Taya

On 4 February 2002, the Prosecution started the third week of its case by calling witness Muharem Krzić who was one of the founders of the SDA (the Party for Democratic Action) in Banja Luka.

The following day, the Prosecution resumed the examination of Muharem Krzić.

The cross-examination of the witness by the Defence began on 6 February and is scheduled to continue when the Trial Chamber reconvenes on 13 February 2002.

## **Dušan FUŠTAR Case**

Judge Kwon

Following his voluntary surrender on 31 January 2002, Dušan Fuštar made his initial appearance before Judge Kwon on 6 February. The accused waived the right to have the Indictment read out and pleaded not guilty to all 7 counts charged against him.

#### DECISION ON PROSECUTION INTERLOCUTORY APPEAL FROM REFUSAL TO ORDER JOINDER

On 1 February 2002, the Appeals Chamber allowed the Prosecution's appeal (see *Press Release* No. 568).

#### ORDER FOR COMMENCEMENT OF TRIAL

On 4 February 2002, the Trial Chamber ordered as follows:

- (1) the trial shall commence on Tuesday 12 February 2002 with the evidence relevant only to the charges relating to Kosovo.
- (2) the Prosecution shall by noon on Thursday 7 February confirm that the order of witnesses for the trial remains unchanged or file an amended order.

#### **SCHEDULING ORDER**

On 5 February 2002, the Trial Chamber ordered that:

- (1) the provisional Defence filings pursuant to Rule 65 ter (G) of the Rules be filed with the Chamber as of 1 March 2002. These filings shall comprise: a list of witnesses with a summary of their respective testimony as well as an indication as to which provision of the Rules could be relied upon to receive their evidence; a separate list of expert witnesses with the indication as to when their report was ready (or is meant to be ready) and when it was made available (or is planned to be made available) to the Prosecution; a list of exhibits with a brief description of their respective nature and contents:
- (2) the Pre-Defence Conference be held on 20 March 2002;
- (3) the Defence case commence on 25 March 2002;
- (4) depositions pursuant to Rule 71 of the Rules, if any, be taken at a later stage of the Defence case, in accordance with and after further consultation of the parties.
