#### I. OVERVIEW OF COURT PROCEEDINGS:

# MILOŠEVIĆ Case ("Croatia and Bosnia and Herzegovina")

Trial Chamber III – Judges May (Presiding) and Robinson\*

- Witness Zoran Lilić (counsel for the witness and two representatives of the government of Serbia and Montenegro participated in the hearing. The witness has yet to be questioned by an *Amicus Curiae*.)

#### ORDER FOR FILING OF MOTIONS AND RELATED MATTERS

On 13 June 2003, the Pre-Trial Judge decided that the Order for Filing of Motions and Related Matters issued on 2 September 2002 with respect to the Mile Mrkšić case applies *mutatis mutandis* in the proceedings against Miroslav Radić. The Order set out the terms of the filing of motions and other related matters.

#### **DECISION ON FORM OF THE INDICTMENT**

On 19 June 2003, the Trial Chamber granted the Mrkšić Defence Motion in part as set out in the Decision. The amended Indictment is to be filed no later than 12 p.m. on 21 July 2003. The Defence is to file its complaints resulting from the Indictment, if any, no later than 12 p.m. on 20 August 2003.

# DECISION ON PROSECUTION'S MOTION FOR LEAVE TO FILE THIRD AMENDED INDICTMENT

On 17 June 2003, the Trial Chamber granted the Prosecution Motion of 26 May 2003 to amend the Amended Joinder Indictment of 27 May 2002.

#### **SCHEDULING ORDER**

# THIRD DECISION ON PROSECUTION MOTION FOR ORDERS PURSUANT TO RULE 54 bis AGAINST SERBIA AND MONTENEGRO

On 18 June 2003, the Trial Chamber rejected the Prosecution's 13 December 2002 Application for binding orders with respect to access to government archives under the control of Serbia and Montenegro.

# DECISION ON URGENT MOTION FOR *EX PARTE* ORAL HEARING ON ALLOCATION OF RESOURCES TO THE DEFENCE AND CONSEQUENCES THEREOF FOR THE RIGHTS OF THE ACCUSED TO A FAIR TRIAL

On 17 June 2003, the Trial Chamber dismissed the Defence 10 April 2003 Request for an *ex parte* Oral Hearing on Allocation of Resources to the Defence and Consequences Thereof for the Rights of the Accused to a Fair Trial.

#### DECISION ON MOTION FOR LEAVE TO AMEND THE AMENDED INDICTMENT

On 18 June 2003, the Trial Chamber decided, *inter alia*, to postpone the final decision on the Prosecution 25 March 2003 Motion to amend the Amended Indictment until the Appeals Chamber has issued its Decision on the joint Interlocutory Appeal. The Request filed by the Hadžihasanović Defence for Stay of the Proceedings on 25 April 2003 was dismissed.
