On 10 December 2003, the parties appeared before the Trial Chamber for the pronouncement of the Sentencing Judgement in the *Dragan Obrenović* case. The Trial Chamber sentenced Dragan Obrenović to 17 years' imprisonment (see *Press Release* No. 809). On 21 May 2003, Dragan Obrenović had pleaded guilty to count five of the Indictment, persecutions on political, racial and religious grounds, a crime against humanity (see *Press Release* No. 756).
