## Vladimir KOVAČEVIĆ Case ("Dubrovnik")

#### **SENTENCING JUDGEMENT**

On 18 March 2004, the parties appeared before the Trial Chamber for the pronouncement of the Sentencing Judgement in the Miodrag Jokić case. Miodrag Jokić pleaded guilty to all six counts of violations of the laws or customs of war in the Second Amended Indictment on 27 August 2003 (see Press Release No. 776). The Trial Chamber sentenced Miodrag Jokić to seven years' imprisonment (see Press Release No. 832). The Office of the Prosecutor had recommended that the Trial Chamber impose a sentence of 10 years, while the Defence had recommended a sentence of less than two years' imprisonment.

## CONCERNING ALLEGATIONS AGAINST MILKA MAGLOV DECISION ON MOTION FOR ACQUITTAL PURSUANT TO RULE 98 BIS

On 19 March 2004, the Trial Chamber granted the confidential Rule 98 bis Motion in part with respect to Count 3 of the allegations regarding the disclosure of the whereabouts of the Witness to a member of the public in violation of an order of a Chamber. The Trial Chamber declared that with regards to this specific part of the Charge, there was no case to answer on the part of the Respondent.
