MILOŠEVIĆ Case ("Kosovo, Croatia and Bosnia and Herzegovina")

Judge Meron – President of the Tribunal

On 25 March 2004, the President of the Tribunal convened a hearing to ascertain whether the Accused would give his consent to a continuation of the proceedings with a substitute Judge, following the resignation of Presiding Judge May pursuant to Rule 15 *bis* (C) of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence. President Meron took the Accused's lack of an affirmative response as withholding his consent to a continuation of proceedings. The matter now rests with the Trial Chamber to decide whether it is in the interests of justice to continue the proceedings with a substitute Judge.

II. OVERVIEW OF SELECTED COURT DOCUMENTS:

BRĐANIN Case ("Krajina")

Appeals Chamber – Judges Meron (Presiding), Shahabuddeen, Güney, El Mahdi and Weinberg de Roca **DECISION ON INTERLOCUTORY APPEAL**

On 19 March 2004, the Appeals Chamber issued a Decision on a Prosecution Interlocutory Appeal concerning Trial Chamber II's acquittal of Radoslav Brdanin on Count 1 of his Indictment on 28 November 2003, following a Motion for Acquittal Pursuant to Rule 98 *bis* of the Tribunal's Rules of Procedure and Evidence. The Appeals Chamber stated the following in its disposition: "The Prosecution's appeal is allowed. The Decision of the Trial Chamber to acquit Brdanin of Count 1 of the Indictment, genocide, with respect to the third category of joint criminal enterprise liability is reversed, and that Count re-instated". Judge Shahabuddeen appended a separate opinion to the Decision (see *Press Release* No. 833).

On 26 March 2004, the Appeals Chamber issued a Decision allowing the Defence interlocutory appeal against the Trial Chamber Decision that denied Naser Orić's request for the application of Rule 70(F) to information that was to be provided to him. The Impugned decision was set aside and the Motion of the Accused was remitted to the Trial Chamber for further consideration in light of this Decision.
