On 2 June 2004, the Trial Chamber deferred the delivery of the Babić Sentencing Judgement until further order (see *Press Advisory* No. 178).

Eighth week of the Prosecution case.

On 1 and 2 June 2004, witness Charles Kirudja was examined by the Prosecution and subsequently cross-examined by the Defence. On 3 and 4 June 2004, the hearing took place in closed session.

HADŽIHASANOVIĆ and KUBURA Case ("Central Bosnia")

Trial Chamber II - Judges Antonetti (Presiding), Rasoazanany and Swart

23rd week of the Prosecution case.

On 1 June 2004, Witness Torbjorn Junhov was examined by the Prosecution and subsequently cross-examined by the Defence. From 2 to 4 June 2004, the Prosecution presented video evidence.

DECISION ON MOTION BY VOJISLAV ŠEŠELJ CHALLENGING JURISDICTION AND FORM OF INDICTMENT

On 26 May 2004, the Trial Chamber ordered the Prosecution to clarify the ambiguities in paragraphs 11 and 12 of the Indictment. Otherwise, it dismissed the complaints made in Vojislav Šešelj's Motion of 24 December 2003. The Decision was filed on 3 June 2004.

It further requested that Mr. Karremans appear as a witness at the earliest on 16 June or at the latest on 22 June 2004.
