### I. OVERVIEW OF COURT PROCEEDINGS

# KRAJIŠNIK Case ("Bosnia and Herzegovina")

Trial Chamber I - Judges Orie (Presiding), El Mahdi and Martín Canivell

Ninth week of the Prosecution case.

On 7 June 2004, the hearing took place in closed session. The Trial was then adjourned until 14 June 2004.

# BLAGOJEVIĆ and JOKIĆ Case ("Srebrenica")

Trial Chamber I, Section A – Judges Liu (Presiding), Vassylenko and Argibay

Ninth week of the Defence case.

From 7 to 11 June 2004, the following witnesses were examined by the Defence and subsequently cross-examined by the Prosecution:

- Witness Petar Salapura
- Witness Dragomir Keserović
- Witness Mirko Trivić

On 8 June 2004, the parties presented their arguments concerning the Prosecution 14 May 2004 Motion to amend the Indictment pursuant to Rule 50 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence. The Trial Chamber rendered its written Decision dismissing the Prosecution Motion on 10 June 2004 (see below).

# REASONS FOR DECISION DISMISSING INTERLOCUTORY APPEAL CONCERNING JURISDICTION OVER THE TERRITORY OF KOSOVO

On 8 June 2004, the Appeals Chamber issued its Reasons for the 12 May 2004 "Decision on Interlocutory Appeal" (see *Weekly Update* No. 314). Judge Shahabuddeen appended a Declaration to the Reasons. On 12 May 2004, the Appeals Chamber had dismissed General Ojdanić's Appeal against the "Decision on Motion Challenging Jurisdiction" rendered by Trial Chamber III on 6 May 2003 (summarised in *Judicial Supplement* No. 41).
